

MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

>>> CARE AND CLEANING OF THE WALL PANEL SYSTEM

While powder coated metal surfaces are durable and resilient they are not immune to scratches and chips. Avoid allowing surfaces to come in contact with sharp metal objects and tools. Proper care and maintenance will drastically enhance and extend the service life of your wall panel product.

Cleaning Surfaces

Clubline wall panels are made using high pressure laminates and anodized aluminum extrusions. Both are highly impervious to most household and industrial cleaners. Non-abrasive water based cleaners like 409, Fantastik, Simple Green and citrus based cleaners like simple orange and Zep cleaner and degreaser work best for cleaning smudges and finger prints etc. For hard to remove stains on both the laminate wall panels and the anodized aluminum extrusions industrial cleaners like Acetone or denatured alcohol can also be used.

Care should be taken not to use excess amounts of liquid cleaners or let other liquids pool or puddle in the extrusion channels. Clubline wall panels are not designed for outdoor applications and all considerations should be made to ensure that they are not exposed to rain or the elements.

Periodic Maintenance

Small scratches can sometimes be made less conspicuous by applying citrus cleaners like Goo gone or Scotts Liquid Gold and rubbing the area to a blended sheen. Heavily damaged panels can be replaced relatively easy by removing the top "J" track and removing the panel in question and replacing with a new panel. This can be done on any particular cell of wall panels without de-constructing large areas.
